



Germany has transposed the EU WEEE Directive (2012/19/EU) into national law. **The new WEEE Act (ElektroG) has come into force on 24th October 2015.** As in all other EU member states, **producers not being established in Germany are required to appoint a so-called Authorized Representative (AR)** according to art. 8 ElektroG in order to fulfill their obligations.

This includes among others:

- ✓ **Foreign producers selling EEE directly to German end-users (distance sellers)**
- ✓ **Foreign producers selling EEE to German distribution partners**
